1. Which headline in the sermon (political division, AI fears, loneliness, etc.) hits closest to home for you right now? Why?
  2. Have you ever noticed Politicism or Scientism shaping your identity or reactions more than your faith in Jesus? Share an example.
  3. Read Colossians 1:15–20 slowly out loud. Which phrase about Jesus stands out most to you today, and why?
  4. How does viewing politics or science as ultimate saviors actually make our problems worse instead of better?
  5. The sermon said Jesus turns “We vs. They” into “Us.” Where do you need His reconciling blood to bring peace in a specific relationship or situation?
  6. What is one practical step this week to let Jesus be the Answer instead of defaulting to political outrage or intellectual pride?
  7. In what ways have you personally experienced the “We vs. They” mindset that Politicism or Scientism creates, and how does Jesus’ declaration that all things were created through Him and for Him (Col. 1:16) challenge that division?
  8. When you feel anxious about headlines—AI, pandemics, loneliness, political chaos—where do you naturally turn first for comfort or solutions? How does knowing Jesus “holds all things together” (Col. 1:17) change your first move?
  9. Imagine someone you care about who believes politics or science alone can fix everything. What one truth from Colossians 1:15–20 would you most want them to hear, and how would you say it in your own words?
