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1. When was the last time you thought or said, "That shouldn't be like this"? What made you feel that way?
 2. How does the constant judging in our world (news, social media, relationships) contribute to your own stress or anxiety?
 3. Read Genesis 3:1-6. What key elements stand out in the serpent's conversation with Eve?
 4. How does the prohibition on the Tree of Knowledge of Good and Evil show God's desire for a loving relationship rather than forced obedience?
 5. Read Romans 5:8. What does this verse reveal about God's timing in demonstrating love?
 6. In what ways do the lies about God, us, and the world in Genesis 3 still echo in modern culture?
 7. Where in your daily life (work, family, self-talk) are you "sitting in the judge's seat" instead of trusting God? Share if comfortable.
 8. How does Romans 5:8 challenge our tendency to judge others, knowing God loved and died for us while we were still in rebellion?
 9. Compare the devastation of judgment in Genesis 3 with the flourishing promised in Revelation 22—which aspect of the future healing do you need most right now?
 10. What one step will you take this week to replace judgment with love? Pray together for grace in those areas.
