1. What's one "possession" in your life (like time, relationships, or resources) that feels out of your control lately? How does that connect to the sermon's story of broken trust?
 2. Share a time when a small temptation led to bigger consequences—how does that mirror the illustration of planting in the forbidden field?
 3. What does the Bible say about Satan's role as "prince of this world" (John 12:31; 14:30; 16:11) and "god of this age" (2 Corinthians 4:4)? How do these titles describe our current reality?
 4. Observe Romans 8:19-22—what words describe creation's suffering, and why was it "subjected to frustration"?
 5. How does Ephesians 6:12 explain our struggle against "powers of this dark world"? What does this mean for daily life?
 6. In Colossians 1:15-17, what phrases show Jesus as Creator? How does this contrast with evil powers possessing the world?
 7. Describe a personal area where you feel "enslaved" to sin or darkness—how might Jesus as Recreator (Colossians 1:18-22) bring freedom there?
 8. Why is Jesus called our Kinsman Redeemer? How does His cross provide both redemption and forgiveness (Colossians 1:13-14)?
 9. Evaluate: In what ways does our culture reflect the "present evil age" (Galatians 1:4)? How can we live as rescued people in it?
 10. What one action will you take this week to live out "Jesus our redeemer restores us to life through his cross"? Share a prayer request for support.
