Bible Texts: Luke 24:1-12

**Big Idea: Jesus' empty tomb changes everything—transforming defeat into victory.**

1. What is one area of your life right now that feels “defeated” or obscured by fog—perhaps guilt, fear, or worry?
2. Share a time when partial information (like the Waterloo fog) led you or someone you know to believe the wrong story.
3. What do you observe about the women’s actions and emotions in Luke 24:1-4?
4. How do the angels’ words in Luke 24:5-7 reframe the women’s expectations?
5. What does Luke 24:11 reveal about the disciples’ first response, and why might that have been culturally expected?
6. In what ways does Peter’s action in verse 12 demonstrate a shift from skepticism to investigation?
7. Which of the three main points 1) Jesus Is Far More than Anyone Expected, 2) Anchor Your Heart in God’s Winning Plan, or 3) Take the Step No One Can Take for You—most resonates with you right now? Why?
8. How does the resurrection truth speak specifically to guilt from your past, fear in your present, or worry about your future?
9. What practical step could you take this week to “run to the empty tomb” and investigate Jesus for yourself or someone you love?
10. How will you live out the Big Idea this week? Share one prayer request for support in embracing the risen Jesus.
