4. Observe the five hazards—complacency, distractions, difficulties, attack, and pride. Which one feels most subtle or dangerous in your current season?
5. How does Matthew 28:18-20 describe Jesus' mission, and why does the sermon call it our "north star"?
6. Look at Ephesians 6:12—what does it mean that our struggle is not against flesh and blood?
7. In what ways have you seen one of these hazards quietly drift you from advancing God's kingdom?
8. Which of the six strategies feels most needed in your life right now, and why?
