1. What's one word or phrase that comes to mind when you think about your earthly father? How has that word shaped the way you see fatherhood or authority figures?
  2. Have you ever found it difficult to see God as a loving, trustworthy Father? What experiences or messages contributed to that picture?
  3. In Genesis 3:1-5, what exact words does the serpent use to cast doubt on God's character and motives? How do these same lies show up in our culture today?
  4. According to the sermon, what are the four specific lies the father of lies sows in our hearts? Which one do you see most often believed around you?
  5. Read John 8:44. How does Jesus describe the devil's nature, native language, and strategy? Why is this important for understanding spiritual warfare?
  6. Jesus declares in John 14:9, "Anyone who has seen me has seen the Father." How does this single statement confront and correct the polluted pictures of God we often carry?
  7. The sermon says, "If your picture of God does not match who Jesus is, it is polluted." Where might your current mental picture of God need cleansing or correction?
  8. Which of the four lies has most affected your relationship with God in the past or present? What truth from Jesus can replace that lie this week?
  9. The sermon challenges us to 1) Identify the lie, 2) Replace it with truth, and 3) Confide in a trusted friend. Which of these three steps will you take first this week, and why?
  10. How will you live out the truth this week that "what comes into your mind when you think about God is the most important thing about you"? Share one specific prayer request for accountability and support.
